Arrival & Departure Plan

- Welcome to Kinsale and we look forward to a great champions.
- The purpose of this plan is to facilitate efficient and safe launch and recovery operations
- As your safety and that of your fellow competitors and volunteers is paramount, your co-operation adhering with this plan is appreciated in advance

First Some Rules

- On arrival, please make your way safely to one of the [designated parking areas](#) to ensure traffic disruption is minimised. Please proceed to prepare you boat for launching as soon as possible. If you need assistance, just let us know.
- Prior to launching all boats will be scrutineered. Please have your boat in measurement trim. Boats will be weighed when craned in.
- Please adhere to the [one-way traffic flow system](#) on the pier and any instructions from KYC volunteers.
- Craning operations will be completed by experienced KYC volunteers. Your cooperation is requested in advance.
- In keeping with Irish law, all competitors must wear life-jackets when on the water.
- Once launched/recovered, please leave the pier area without delay

On Arrival



- Park safely in one of the designated parking areas as is available.
- Proceed to the race office and register.
- Proceed to rig and prepare your boat for scrutineering. Please ensure your boat has all equipment onboard in line with class rules, and is presented in a dry condition.
- When ready to be scrutineered and launched, please inform a KYC volunteer.
- To facilitate launching, please ensure your backstay remains disconnected and your floorboard is lifted.
- Please adhere to the one-way traffic flow system on the commercial pier

Scrutineering & Launching

- Your boat will be moved to the pier if not already located there.
- A member of the measurement team will inspect your boat for compliance with class rules. Please ensure your boat has all necessary equipment onboard and tanks/bilge areas are in a dry condition. [See check sheet](#)
- Once complete, your boat will be moved to the crane area. Certified lifting straps will be fitted by the crane operators. Bow and stern lines will be handled by the lifting/out team.
- Please adhere to the one-way traffic flow system on the commercial pier
- Once weighing is complete and your boat is launched, please proceed to the designated steps to the pontoon to receive your boat.
- A RIB will tow you to the berthing area.


Trailer Parking



- Once your boat is launched, your trailer will be tagged and you will be instructed to remove your trailer for the pier without delay.
- Your cooperation in this regard is appreciated in advance. Delays doing so will delay launching operations

Berthing

- On arrival in the designated berthing area in KYC marina, you will be received by KYC volunteers. One of them can be a bit cranky, so best to follow any instructions provided.
- Boats will be rafted against each other for the duration of the regatta.
- If, for ease of access you require your boat to be berthed alongside the marina, please inform the volunteers on the marina.
- Please ensure you bring sufficient fenders to protect your boat.

Recovery

- Early Friday morning, please bring your trailer to the pier and yacht club dinghy park as space allows.
- Trailers will be arranged in order of recovery by KYC volunteers.
- After racing proceed to the marina and prepare your boat for lifting.
- A RIB's will be available to tow boats from the marina to the craning out pontoon.
- Once lifted, please de-rig and secure your boat as soon as possible.
- Boats should be removed from the pier without delay to facilitate ongoing lifting operations.
